

Christchurch Girls' High School Cranmer Square Bead



Many of us are mourning the loss of our Cranmer Square buildings following the September 2010 and February 2011 earthquakes and aftershocks. To many of us they *were* Girls' High.

The Old Girls' Committee is fortunate to have been given the opportunity to commemorate our old school through the creation of a silver bead of the building. This is available in the form of a slim **pendant** (TK1), a hollow **charm bracelet** bead (TK2), a **Pandora-style** bead (TK3), and a bead with a **hanging clasp** (TK4). The examples shown below are of Rangi Ruru's *Te Koraha* heritage building.

Each CGHS sterling silver bead is available for \$70, or two for \$130, plus postage and packaging. Proceeds will go towards Christchurch Girls' High recovery projects.
