

STUDENT USE OF CARS

RATIONALE:

Students may wish to bring a car to school.

PURPOSE:

To provide an awareness of and control over motor vehicles being brought to school.

GUIDELINES:

1. The right to have a car at school will be subject to the Principal's approval, and applications must be made to her in writing by a parent/caregiver of the student concerned.
2. Parent/caregiver and student must complete the appropriate documentation before permission will be granted.
3. If a student with a full licence is to carry passengers, written permission must be given by both the parent(s) of the driver and the parent(s) of the passenger(s).
4. Should it be necessary to use the car for any other purpose, special permission must be given by parent/caregiver and, in the event of a school-related activity, the teacher involved.
5. When brought to school the car must be parked in the designated area according to student year level, and must display the Christchurch Girls' High School permission sticker. Year 13 students should park by the school tennis courts in Matai Street, other students must park in Mona Vale Avenue. Students are not to park in Darvel Street.
6. The school is not responsible for any damage to the car or injury to the driver and/or passengers at any time.
7. Failure to comply with any of the above conditions will result in withdrawal of permission and may also result in other punishment.
