



## CURRICULUM

**Christchurch Girls' High School - offers its students a curriculum which meets the requirements of the NZ Curriculum, reflects the academic nature of the school, and prepares students for further tertiary study and life long learning.**

Christchurch Girls' High School will ensure:

- The school curriculum will meet the requirements and intent of the NZ Curriculum.
- Subjects and teaching opportunities will be offered which as much as possible accommodate the abilities and needs of all students.
- From the subjects offered at the school, students will be able to progress both to tertiary study and into immediate employment.

Therefore:

1. The appropriateness and viability of subjects will be reviewed at regular intervals and the curriculum will be reviewed on an ongoing basis.
2. Appropriate professional development will be offered to all staff to enable them to keep up with curriculum developments and to deliver the curriculum to the best of their ability.
3. Applications from staff for new courses at any level will be received and considered in Term 1 each year, as relevant.
4. Final decisions will be made by the Senior Team and ratified by the Board of Trustees following presentations, and full discussion by staff. These decisions will then be conveyed to staff.
5. Details about new courses will be included in the information made available in school publications and at the subject choice afternoon.
