



5.23 STUDENT USE OF CARS

Students may wish to bring a car to school.

PURPOSE:

To provide an awareness of and control over motor vehicles being brought to school.

GUIDELINES:

1. The right to have a car at school will be subject to the Principal's approval, or delegated member of staff and applications must be made to them- in writing by a parent/caregiver of the student concerned.
2. Parent/caregiver and student must complete the appropriate documentation before permission will be granted.
3. If a student with a full licence is to carry passengers, written permission must be given by both the parent(s) of the driver and the parent(s) of the passenger(s).
4. Should it be necessary to use the car for any other purpose, special permission must be given by parent/caregiver and, in the event of a school-related activity, the teacher involved.
5. When brought to school the car must display the Christchurch Girls' High School /**Te Kura o Hine Waiora** permission sticker.
6. The school is not responsible for any damage to the car or injury to the driver and/or passengers at any time.
7. Failure to comply with any of the above conditions will result in withdrawal of permission and may also result in other punishment.
