



1.4 CURRICULUM

Christchurch Girls' High School / *Te Kura o Hine Waiora* offers its students a curriculum which meets the requirements of the NZ Curriculum, reflects the academic nature of the school, and prepares students for further tertiary study and life long learning.

Christchurch Girls' High School / *Te Kura o Hine Waiora* will ensure:

- The school curriculum will meet the requirements and intent of the NZ Curriculum.
- Subjects and teaching opportunities will be offered which as much as possible accommodate the abilities and needs of all students.
- From the subjects offered at the school, students will be able to progress both to tertiary study and into immediate employment.

Therefore:

1. The appropriateness and viability of subjects will be reviewed at regular intervals and the curriculum will be reviewed on an ongoing basis. Any change to curriculum will be based on both feedback and in consultation with staff, students whanau community.
2. Appropriate professional learning and development will be offered to all staff to enable them to keep up with curriculum developments and to deliver the curriculum to the best of their ability.
3. Final decisions regarding change will be made by the Senior Leadership Team. These decisions will then be conveyed to staff.
4. Details about courses will be included in the information made available in school publications and at the subject choice afternoon.
5. With the shift to more personalised learning and student agency, gifted and talented students will have IEP's and given opportunities both inside and outside school to support their individual needs. (eg academic, leadership, sporting etc).
